- Build and decorate your own Ukulele!




• Learn basic chords, fingerings, strumming, and simple songs!

This class would provide an accessible introduction to the fundamentals of guitar playing, catering to beginners with no or little prior experience. Students will learn essential skills such as proper hand positioning, basic chord progressions, and simple songs, while developing a deeper appreciation for music. This class will be perfect for students who have completed the 6th grade general music guitar unit and are looking to advance their skill and HAVE MORE FUN playing guitar!


### Intro to Electric Bass (Nev

- -Lincoln JHS (Monday-Friday) 11:30-12:30 \$115
  - Wednesday June 4th to Friday June 27th
  - For students entering 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th grade
  - Electric Basses and amps will be provided (feel free to bring your own!)

For students who have completed 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade. This class will introduce students to the fundamentals of playing electric bass, focusing on essential techniques such as finger placement, basic rhythms, and simple basslines. The electric bass is a versatile instrument used in many music genres, from rock to jazz, making it both fun and rewarding to learn. Additionally, skills learned in this course will put students on the path to be able to participate in their school's jazz band, where the bass plays a key role in supporting rhythm and harmony.
