Registration Process

Everything that a parent needs to register a student who was enrolled in District 203 last year is contained in this envelope. Please drop off/mail in all forms, Student Quick Pay payment receipt or personal check to: 201 N. Washington Street, Naperville IL, 60540 by <u>Friday, August 9th</u>.

Be sure to include....

Fee Sheet (w/cash or check made out to District 203). PE Shirt Order for 6th - 8th Grade (If Needed) Physical form(s)

- All incoming sixth graders must have a school physical.
- All incoming 7th & 8th graders who wish to participate in interscholastic sports **must** have a <u>sports physical</u>.
- <u>All sports physicals are valid for one year only</u>. Athletes **must** have a valid sports physical as of the first day of tryouts or practice, and to include the last day of the season! Fall sports begin the week of August 19th.

August 7th and August 8th are Student Orientation Days in our Cafeteria

- All incoming 6th graders will meet from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. on August 7th
- All New 7th & 8th graders will meet from 10:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. on August 7th
- All incoming 5th graders will meet from 12:00 p.m. until 2:00 p.m. on August 7th

- All <u>Returning</u> 7th & 8th graders may pick up their schedule beginning at 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on August 8th

School Supplies

- If you ordered a school supply kit in the spring through Home & School, that kit can be picked up during Student Orientation Days
- If you did not order a kit but would like one, there will be a small number of extra kits available for purchase at that time on a first come, first served basis.
- Please remember that even if you purchased a kit, the required calculators are not included.

Curriculum Night

Please mark your calendars for Thursday, August 22nd at 6:00 p.m (5th Grade) and 7:00 p.m. (6th-8th Grades). School calendars with all school information will be passed out that night.

Washington's 7th & 8th Grade Interscholastic Sports



Interscholastic sports are offered to all <u>7th and 8th grade boys and girls</u> at Washington Junior High. Interscholastic sports take place outside of regular school hours and are in addition to the regular physical education program. Students are required to have a <u>current sports</u> <u>physical examination on file at school before they can try-out or participate in a sport</u>.

INTERSCHOLASTIC SPORTS OFFERED:

- Fall: Flag Football (non-cut), Cross Country (non-cut), and Girls' Volleyball
- Winter: Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball, Wrestling (non-cut), and Cheerleading
- Spring: Track (non-cut)

INTERSCHOLASTIC SPORTS PARTICIPATION:

- Read about the Interscholastic Sports offered at WJHS and view the 2024-2025 sports schedules on the <u>WJHS website → Athletics</u>.
- Obtain a <u>current Sports Physical</u> (form online) and return it to the Nurses' Office. It is
 imperative that your child has a current Sports Physical on file prior to a try-out and/or
 participation in any sport.
- A <u>\$50 athletic fee</u> will be required for each sport your daughter/son participates in. This fee can be paid at the start of each season along with a signed permission slip. The <u>signed</u> <u>permission slip</u> and <u>\$50 athletic fee</u> should be signed and returned to the Main Office or coach(es) directly.
- Students/athletes involved in any sport must remain academically eligible to participate in their specific activity.

Washington's 5th - 8th Grade Intramurals

A variety of intramural activities are offered to 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students throughout the year. These activities are designed for students to learn new skills, meet new friends, and have fun. Students should listen for morning announcements, refer to Wildcat TV and reminders during lunch periods, and take note of flyers posted around the school to learn of specific meeting dates and times.

INTRAMURAL PARTICIPATION:

- Read about Intramurals offered at WJHS and view the 2024-2025 Intramural Schedule on the <u>WJHS website → Athletics → Intramurals</u>.
- A one-time <u>\$26 intramural fee</u> will be required for unlimited participation in <u>ALL</u> intramurals. This fee should be paid at the start of the first intramural your daughter/son participates in along with a signed permission slip from the sponsor(s). A <u>signed permission slip</u> and the <u>one-time \$26 intramural fee</u> should be signed and returned to the Main Office or sponsor(s) directly.
- Each intramural sponsor will communicate their schedules as the intramural gets closer to the start date. A flyer will be available, with an opportunity for the student to have the sheet signed and returned to the teacher facilitating the activity.


