#### General Announcements:

- Next year, the district is moving forward with full, 5-day in person learning. 4% of students/parents from the survey opted for alternate form of education. District working on alternatives/ Online Academy.
- Quarantines continue to be a huge frustration. If a school cannot guarantee at least 6 ft. of social distancing, then the quarantine remains at 14 days. Otherwise it is 10 days.
- D203 website will undergo a revision for next year
- Quarantining and masking mandates driven by county and state public health departments, not the District.
- District is currently preparing a budget for next year with funds committed to Return to Learn and make up for unfinished learning.
- Summer: Free course will be offered for summer of 2021 or 2022. Bridge courses, Jumpstart courses and Algebra Essentials courses offered along with AP Boot Camps.
- School Year: Increase number of specialists, provide intensive tutoring and additional SEL support in place, focus on specific skills to help students meet essential standards.
- This summer, district to focus on "Being Bold and Being Innovative." Want to come back stronger.
- Reminder of Covid vaccination taking place May 22 at Neuqua Valley High School. Sign
  up link on school website. There are 6,000 slots and 600 have been filled. The
  government just approved Pfizer vaccine for 12-15-year olds for emergency use, so
  they will soon be eligible to sign up for this vaccine clinic.
